**LISTED BELOW ARE THE RULES AND THE PUBLICITY OF THE
INDIANA POSTAL WORKERS UNION
CLIFF BASS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2010**

1. The name of the scholarship will be: The Cliff Bass Memorial Scholarship
2. Fund raisers may be set up by the Scholarship Committee.
3. The accounts of money that are awarded for the scholarship will be contingent on the amount that is in the Fund. We will award four (4) scholarships.
(A) One \$1000.00 Scholarship
(B) Three \$500.00 Scholarships
4. The selection committee will be three (3) faculty members from the Labor/Economics Department at Indiana colleges/universities. The 1996 committee will be from IU Bloomington, and 1997 committee will be from Valparaiso. Thereafter, the Scholarship Committee will designate the college/university.
5. Four (4) alternates' names will not be revealed and will be held by the State Secretary-Treasurer in the case of the unavailability of the winners.
6. **An essay must be submitted with application. Essays will be 1000-2500 words in length. The essay shall be about unionism.**
7. The only requirement for eligibility for the scholarships are that the applicant be enrolled in an Undergraduate program in a College or Vocational Institution for the fall of the year that the scholarship is being awarded, and that a parent or legal guardian or grandparent in the bargaining unit be a member of an APWU Local or M..A.L. that belongs to the Indiana Postal Workers Union. Also, if the member is deceased, that they were a member of a Local which belongs to the Indiana Postal Workers Union, or Member-At-Large of the IPWU at the time of death. The applicant can receive a scholarship on a one-time basis in each of the two (2) categories. One time winner of the essay, and one time winner of the drawing.
8. In the September-October and November-December newsletters (The Indiana Postal Workers Union Dispatch) there will be an announcement of the scholarship and information on how to apply.
9. **(A) Applications with essays will be accepted from November 14, 2009 through February 14, 2010. Certified mail is suggested.**
(B) The committee will make their winning essay selection no later than March 14th.
(C) The winners will be notified by April 1st by certified mail and must RSVP within 14 days.
(D) All four (4) winners will be invited to attend the State Convention to officially be Presented with their scholarships.
(E) Dinner (only) will be paid for by the IPWU for the winners and parents/guardians.
(F) The State Secretary-Treasurer will do the inviting per an Express Mail letter in time for official notification with a copy to the State President.
(G) The applicant will sign the application form in which it gives the IPWU permission to print the essay and photographs of the winners.
(H) The applicant must submit proof of application to be accepted at a college, university, or vocational institution.
(I) Funds for the scholarships will be paid to the institution. If the winner/winners does not/do not attend, the refund will be returned to the IPWU.
10. **The responsibility for submitting a completed application and required materials rest with the applicant.**
11. The sponsoring employee to the applicant can not have been in/or applied for a management position at least one (1) year prior to applicant applying for and/or being Awarded scholarship. Also, sponsoring employee to the applicant can not go into or apply for a management position at least one (1) year after applicant receives the funds or the funds must be returned immediately by the sponsoring employee.
